Nebraska Student-Centered Assessment System (NSCAS)

Students in grades 3-8 will participate in the state assessments in English Language Arts (ELA), Math, and Science this spring. The testing window opens March 19, 2018. Arbor View will begin assessing students during the week of March 26, due to spring break. All testing should be completed by April 27, with make-ups possible during the week of April 30. Arbor View will be creating a testing schedule. Please let your child's teacher know if your child will be gone anytime between March 26 and April 27. It will help us with planning ahead.




