Nebraska Student-Centered Assessment System (NSCAS)

Students in grades 3-8 will participate in the state assessments in English Language Arts (ELA), Math, and Science this spring. The testing window opens March 19, 2018. Arbor View will begin assessing students during the week of March 26, due to spring break. All testing should be completed by April 27, with make-ups possible during the week of April 30. 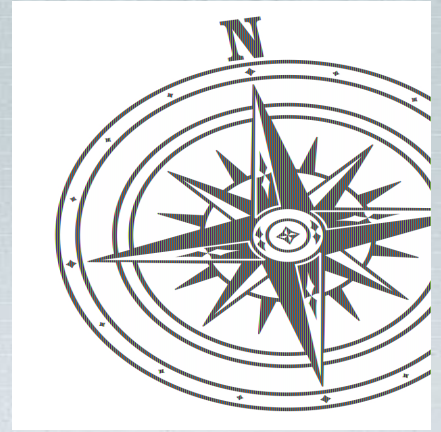

Thank you to our awesome health screen volunteers. We couldn't have done it without you!

If your child had results that indicated a need for further evaluation, you should be receiving those referrals in the mail. Please return a copy of the completed referral, so I can update your child's health information. Thank you!

As we head into the winter months, we see an increase in cold and flu symptoms. Please keep your child home if they have a fever of 100* or greater, vomiting/diarrhea, persistent cough, unknown rashes, pinkeye, or in general not feeling well. This helps your child get well faster, and helps reduce the spread of germs.
