The following are topics that 11th Grade TA advisers are asked to cover with their advisees. How and when are at the discretion of the advisor.

AUGUST:

- First day and week rules & policies (per Administrators)
- Explain objectives of grade level TAs
 - Develop Relationships with TA Advisor and classmates
 - Track academic progress
 - Plan registration
 - Discuss post-secondary plans
 - Focus on specific needs of each grade level

- Passing period Do's and Don'ts
- Emergency Procedures
- Agenda
- Activity Pass - available in Activities Office

- Extracurricular Participation/Expectations as observer or participant
- Clubs—encourage new students to attend club meetings and to try to join at least one club. Listen to announcements for dates and times.

- Define **National Honor Society** requirements
 - Junior or Senior with cumulative GPA of at least 3.5
 - Must demonstrate excellence in the areas of service, leadership, and character.
 - Membership is determined by the Faculty Council and based on a point system.
 - Induction occurs in mid-September.
