Parents are encouraged to pre-register their students prior to Kindergarten Roundup and orientation. Children who will be five years of age on or before July 31, 2017 are eligible to attend kindergarten according to Nebraska State Law.

Kindergarten Roundup will be held Friday, March 2nd. Parents are encouraged to attend an orientation meeting held at their school prior to Kindergarten Roundup on Monday, February 26th at 6:00.

- 5. <u>Firmly secure</u> the mitten(s) to the outside of the wrapped item. This is the only way we know what is inside of the gift and who the gift belongs to.
- 6. Return the wrapped item to the office, no later than Friday, December 8th at 3 pm.
