Happy Friday Hillrise Families!

This past week we have been MAP testing in grades 2-5. Map (Measure of Academic Progress) is a computer-adaptive test. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. MAP uses a RIT scale to accurately measure what students know, regardless of their grade level. It also measures growth over time, allowing you to track your child's progress throughout the school year and across multiple years. After each test, your child receives a RIT score. RIT scores have the same meaning across grade levels. If a fourth-grade student and an eighthgrade student have the same RIT score in reading, then they are testing at the same level in that subject. Teachers use these scores to help drive small group instruction/practice. It is gives us great data!
