Just a reminder that students will be going outside each day for recess and walking club, weather permitting. Please make sure that your child dresses appropriately so that he or she can enjoy their time outdoors.

Please remember that school doors do not open until 7:55 AM for walking club. Please do not drop off your children before 7:55 AM unless they are coming for breakfast as there is no supervision until that time.

#### <u>MAKEUP DAYS FOR MISSED SCHOOL DAYS</u>

The Elkhorn Board of Education has built in two makeup days to the calendar in the event that school is canceled due to inclement weather (snow days). The first two missed days will be made up; in the event of three or more snow days, the administration will reevaluate the calendar at that time.

The first makeup day is scheduled for Thursday, May 24, and the second makeup day is Friday, May 25. Both days become vacation days if we haven't had any missed school days.



Student safety takes a priority over any vehicle and driver at Manchester Elementary. Please take a moment to ask yourself these questions. If you answer yes to even one of them, you may be placing a child at risk.

- •Are you driving too fast?
- •Are you in too big of a hurry?
- Are you asking your child to cross through traffic?
- •Do you allow your child to ride without a seatbelt?

Please remember to follow the drop-off and pick-up procedures.

- •Always have your child exit and enter the vehicle curbside.
- •Pull <u>all</u> the way forward up to the ramp by the kindergarten doors before dropping off and picking up.
- •Please allow your child to walk to the front doors from the spot that your vehicle stops.
- •The staff parking lot is not to be used for dropping off or picking up students.
- •Cars should not be left unattended as this disrupts the flow of traffic.
- •Please follow the directions of staff. They are on duty to provide safety for the students.

#### **Inside or Outside**

In or Out? I hear this asked several times during the winter months. The District's guideline for elementary buildings is that it should be at least 20 degrees with or without the wind-chill. That being said, there may be exceptions. For example, if we have been inside for several days and the temperature with the wind-chill figured in is 19 degrees, we may go out. On the other hand, if the temperature is 25 degrees, but we have new ice that has formed due to melting and refreezing we may stay inside.
