Skyline is seeking to identify children who are eligible for kindergarten during the 2017-2018 school year. Parents are encouraged to pre-register their child prior to Kindergarten Round-up. Children who will be five years of age, on or before July 31, 2017, are eligible to attend kindergarten as stated by Nebraska State Law. Skyline Kindergarten Round-up will be held on Friday, March 3. A parent meeting is scheduled for Monday,

Make-up Days for Missed School Days

The Elkhorn Board of Education has built in two makeup days to the calendar in the event that school is cancelled due to inclement weather (snow days). The first make-up day is scheduled for May 24, 2017. This date will become a vacation day if there are no missed school days due to inclement weather. Please update May 24, 2017 on your calendar, which is now a school day due to the snow day on January 17, 2017. The second make-up day is scheduled for May 25, 2017. This date will become a vacation day if there are no more missed school days due to inclement weather. The first two missed days will be made up; in the event of three or more snow days, the administration will reevaluate the calendar at that time.

Register (new users)

- 1. Enter your email address and push "Login/Create Account".
- 2. Fill in the required fields and register.
- 3. For each child, enter your child's first and last name, with no space, for the Student ID (example: JohnSmith) and Birth Date (example: 12/15/2005).

Sign In

If you've previously registered, all you need to do is enter your email address and password. The system will know about your appointments and the children you have added to your account.

Scheduling

- 1. Each colored square represents an available meeting time. The legend/key shows what each color means. Click on a square to book that time.
- 2. As an option, you have the choice of setting a time when you would like a reminder email delivered.
- 3. Click "Create Appointment" to finalize.

Repeat until you have a time for each of your children.

*At any time, you can click on "printable schedule" and print the resulting web page to get a hard copy of your schedule. You will also have the option to email your schedule to yourself.

*You have the ability to change your conference time through February 12th. You will need to log in with the email address and password you used to create your account. If you need to make a change after February 12th, you will need to contact the classroom teacher or the office at 402-289-3433.

*Click on "Your Schedule" to display and hide your appointments. There will be links to change the time or cancel the appointment.

Winter Reminders and Inclement Weather Alerts



In or Out? This is a question asked several times during the winter months. The district guideline for elementary buildings is that it should be at least 20 degrees with or without the wind chill. At times there are conditions that call for an exception. For example, if we have been inside for several days and the temperature with the wind chill figured in is 19 degrees, we may go out. On the other hand, if the temperature is 25 degrees, but we have new ice that has formed due to melting and refreezing, we may stay inside. Please send your children to school with coats, hats, and gloves when needed!

School closings will be announced on radio station KFAB (1110) and the local TV stations. Elkhorn families will also receive an announcement via SchoolMessenger, the automated telephone announcement service. If there is no closing announcement broadcast, school will be in session. If severe weather develops during the school day, parents/guardians may pick their children up from school. Parents/guardians always have the option of not sending their children to school on a day when inclement weather is developing or has been forecast.



WHEN IS MY CHILD TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

PROPER CARE IN THE EARLY STAGES OF AN ILLNESS CAN REDUCE RECOVERY TIME FOR THE ILL CHILD AND REDUCE THE POSSIBILITY OF SPREADING THE ILLNESS TO OTHERS. PROPER DIET, ADEQUATE REST, AND GOOD PERSONAL HYGIENE (ESPECIALLY FREQUENT HAND WASHING) CAN ASSIST THE BODY'S ABILITY TO FIGHT INFECTION.

THE FOLLOWING ARE GUIDELINES TO ASSIST YOU IN DECIDING WHEN YOUR CHILD SHOULD STAY HOME FROM SCHOOL:

IRRITABILITY, POOR APPETITE, TIREDNESS, AND ACHINESS ARE VAGUE SYMPTOMS.
CHANGES IN A CHILD'S NORMAL BEHAVIOR CAN OFTEN SIGNAL THE BEGINNING OF AN ILLNESS.

FEVER OF 100 DEGREES OR HIGHER. TAKE YOUR CHILD'S TEMPERATURE IF HE IS COMPLAINING OF FEELING TIRED, HAS A HEADACHE, SORE THROAT OR STOMACH ACE. A CHILD NEEDS TO BE FEVER-FREE FOR 24 HOURS WITHOUT THE USE OF FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL.

NAUSEA, VOMITING, OR DIARRHEA. KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME FOR THE DURATION OF THESE SYMPTOMS. NO VOMITING OR DIARRHEA FOR THE PAST 24 HOURS IS RECOMMENDED. BE SURE YOUR CHILD IS ABLE TO TOLERATE FOOD WITHOUT DIFFICULTY BEFORE RETURNING.

NASAL SECRETIONS AND COUGHING/SNEEZING SPREAD RESPIRATORY INFECTIONS EASILY WHEN THESE SYMPTOMS CAN'T BE CONTROLLED.

DAILY SCHOOL HOURS


