NeSA (Grade 3-5) and MAP (Grades 2-5) Testing Schedule

Each spring all District students in grades third, fourth, and fifth complete the Nebraska State Accountability (NeSA) assessments. Plus, all students in grades second through fifth are administered the MAP assessment. Results from the NeSA and MAP assessments are used to identify strengths and areas of need across the District, as well as for each individual student. It is important that your student(s) be present during these assessments in order to get an accurate snapshot of their level of mastery in relation to state standards. These results will also allow our teaching staff to guide classroom instruction based on areas of need. Listed below are the scheduled dates for the NeSA and MAP assessments at Skyline. 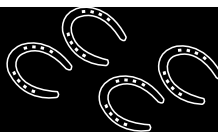
