Student Safety is Our 1st Priority!

Student safety takes priority over any vehicle and driver at Spring Ridge Elementary. Please take a moment to ask yourself these questions. If you answer yes to even one of these, you may be placing a child at risk.

- Are you driving too fast?
- Are you in too big of a hurry?
- Are you parking illegally?
- Are you asking a child to cross through traffic?
- Do you allow your child to ride without a seatbelt?

Please remember to follow our Spring Ridge Drop off and Pick up procedures. Pull as far forward as possible. Always have your child enter and exit curbside. And finally, never ask a child to cross through traffic to meet you.

Please be considerate of our Safety Patrol students. They are doing a great job and are truly interested in the safety of their fellow peers. Thank you for your help in maintaining order and safety during the drop off and pick up times.

Brrr!!!! It's Cold Outside!!!!

- Cold weather is still with us. Coats, hats, mittens are needed most days for walking club and recess. It is helpful if you put your child's name in coats. We can easily return items to your child if there is a name on the tag.
- Students will be going outside for recess and walking club if weather permits. Please
 make sure to dress your children appropriately so that he or she can enjoy his/her time
 outdoors.
- Inclement weather—school closings will be announced on radio KFAB and local television stations. You should also receive a message from the district School Messenger notification system.
- Please remember that school doors do not open until 7:55 a.m. for walking club. Please do not drop off your children before 7:55. There is no supervision until 7:55 a.m. Thank you.





Visitor Guidelines

All visitors are required to sign in/out when arriving and leaving the building.

Visitors will be asked to wear a visitor's badge while in school.

All visitors must use the front entrance. Please do not go to the classrooms without checking in at the office. If you have brought something that your child has forgotten, please drop it off at the office and we will be happy to take it to your child.

NSCAS Testing Timeline

In the past, all students in grades three through eight, as well as 11th grades, have completed the Nebraska State Accountability (NeSA) assessments. This year the test has been renamed Nebraska Student Centered Assessment System. Results from the NSCAS will be used like those from NeSA to identify strengths and areas of need across the district, as well as for each individual student. It is important that your student(s) be present during these assessments in order to get an accurate snapshot of their level of mastery in relation to state standards. These results will also allow our teaching staff to guide classroom instruction based on areas of need. Listed below are the scheduled dates for the NSCAS assessments at Spring Ridge. Please be mindful of these dates when scheduling appointments, vacations, etc. If you have any questions regarding NSCAS assessments or scheduled testing dates, please feel free to contact Laurinda Petersen at 402-637-0204.

New to Spring Ridge and wondering what a Book Swap is?


Book Swap is a time when students can trade in their lightly used books for books that other students have turned into the swap. Here's how it works:



- 2. On the date of the Book Swap (Wednesday, February 21st), students can shop the Swap! They can take up to 4 new-to-them books home. If your child brought 4 or more books to trade, he/she may take 4 books. If your child brings 3 books to trade, he/she may choose 3 to take home, etc.
- 3. What do we do with the extra books? Teachers get to shop the Swap as well! Any remaining books will be donated to an Omaha school or the A Book of My Own program run by the Jr. League of Omaha.

Spring Ridge Drama Club Sign-up



Calling all 4th and 5th Grade Actresses, Actors and Parents!

Spring Ridge in partnership with the "The Rose" will be providing 4th and 5th Grade students and opportunity to explore the art of Drama and the Theater starting late January through the beginning of March. This year the Drama Club is offering two different opportunities:

Intro to Improvisation (Tuesdays)

Jump into the world of improv with these fun improv skill-building activities! Over the course of the residency you will improve your ability to give and take focus, make bold choices with your body and voice, and build on other students' ideas. You will have the opportunity to show off your performance skills during a class sharing for family and friends on the last day of class. The instructor will be Kevin Ehrhart. For the past 22 years, Kevin has taught improvisation, directing, Shakespeare and all forms of creative drama for all ages.

Create Your Own Play and Star in It (Thursdays)

Learn the basics of acting (using our bodies, voices and imaginations) and the basics of playwriting: idea creation, playwriting format, and dramatic structure. Our class will use then improvisation and playwriting to adapt classic fairy tales as our own. Finally, we will use our acting skills to act out our story! The instructor will be Kimberlee Stone who has taught classes in playwriting, storytelling and other workshops at The Rose.

Students may sign-up for either the Tuesday (Intro to Improv) or the Thursday (Create Your Own Play) session, but not both. Classes will start January 18th and run through March 8th. Each class will run from 3:15 PM - 4:45 PM each week and be held in Ms. Loftis' Music Room. Each session is capped at 25 students. Parent volunteers are needed at each session to assist the instructors by keeping an eye on the kids while they provide instruction.
