Snapchat (Snap Inc.) is a picture sharing application targeting 13-24 year-old users. One of the most desirable aspects of Snapchat is that pictures are only available for a limited amount of time, seemingly "disappearing" after being viewed twice. - Snapchat is not intended for children under 13.
- Snap Inc. collects and sells data and location.
- Geographical tracking uses Google Maps to share location with other users.

✘ SAFETY

- False sense of security that pictures 'disappear.'
- Allows direct messaging with photos and text.
- Unable to be monitored by caregivers.
- Ghost Mode must be enabled to protect location.

! CONTENT

- Pictures can be saved in the cloud, and off the device's camera roll, in "My Eyes Only."
- App used to send self-made and digital nudes.
- May contain gossip, polling, drug and alcohol use, profanity, sexualization and objectification.
