ELKHORN PUBLIC SCHOOLS MINUTES OF BOARD OF EDUCATION REGULAR MEETING December 14, 2015

The regular meeting of the Elkhorn Public Schools Board of Education was called to order at 6:30 PM. Members present: J. Marasco, A. Parks, A. Clark, S. Zingler, R. Riggle and C. Burney. Board President J. Marasco noted that the meeting was governed by the Open Meetings Act, a copy of which is posted on the east wall of the Board Room.

For the "Good News Report" J. Marasco reported in November, Elkhorn was named to the College Board's 6th AP District Honor Roll for increasing access to AP coursework while simultaneously maintaining or increasing the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher on the exams. This is the fourth year in a row the District has received this award and EPS was one of only two districts in the state to be named to the list in 2015. Across the district students are participating in community outreach projects during the holiday season. Elkhorn students have collected clothing, toys, food items, diapers and monetary donations to donate to those in need.

The Board received a report on ESHS Student Council Activities from M. Greufe and EHS Student Council Activities from R. Valquier Chavez and A. Wilkins.
