

**ELKHORN PUBLIC SCHOOLS
MINUTES OF BOARD OF EDUCATION
REGULAR MEETING
June 10, 2019**

The regular meeting of the Elkhorn Public Schools Board of Education was called to order at 6:30 PM. Members present: J. Marasco, A. Clark, A. Parks, R. Vokt, and N. Rogic-Greufe. C. Burney absent and excused. President John Marasco noted that the meeting was governed by the Open Meetings Act, a copy of which is posted on the east wall of the Board Room.

For the "Good News Report" J. Marasco congratulated Mia Giandinoto, Megan Raszler, Ted Gernhart, and Michael Kelly for being recognized by Governor Ricketts during a ceremony at the State Capitol for their academic achievement of earning a perfect 36 on the ACT. Also, congratulations to the students at Spring Ridge elementary for being named the Omaha metro area's Pints to Gallons Milk Drive top fundraiser! Students raised more than \$4,000 for community food pantries to purchase an under-donated item: milk. The school was rewarded with a visit from Kansas City Chiefs mascot KC Wolf on May 13th.
