MINUTES OF BOARD OF EDUCATION  
REGULAR MEETING  
November 11, 2019**

The regular meeting of the Elkhorn Public Schools Board of Education was called to order at 6:30 PM. Members present: J. Marasco, A. Parks, C. Burney, R. Vokt, and N. Rogic-Greufe. A. Clark was absent and excused. President John Marasco noted that the meeting was governed by the Open Meetings Act, a copy of which is posted on the east wall of the Board Room.

For the “Good News Report” J. Marasco congratulated the 21 Elkhorn Public Schools high school students named to the All State Band and Orchestra and to the 54 students named to the All State Chorus! Additionally, after winning their building-level competition, 19 EPS elementary and middle school students will participate in the District Spelling Bee on Thursday, November 21<sup>st</sup> at 4:30 PM. Congratulations and good luck to all participants!

It was moved by C. Burney, seconded by A. Parks to approve the Consent Agenda items including: approval of agenda, approval of minutes for Monday, October 14, 2019 and approval of November bills for payment.
