MINUTES OF BOARD OF EDUCATION
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Elkhorn Public Schools Board of Education was called to order at 6:30 PM. Members present: C. Burney, A. Parks, S. Ringenberg, N. Rogic-Greufe J. Shatel, and R. Vokt. President A. Parks noted that the meeting was governed by the Open Meetings Act, a copy of which is posted in the Board Room of the District Office.
