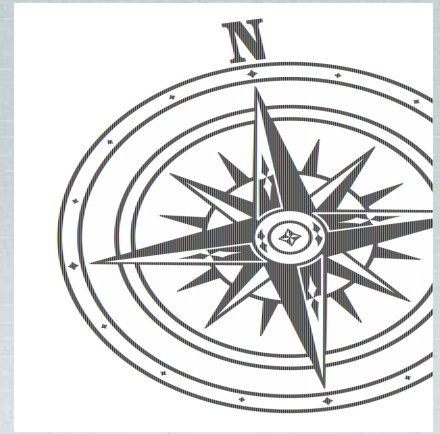

Thank you to our awesome health screen volunteers. We couldn't have done it without you!

If your child had results that indicated a need for further evaluation, you should be receiving those referrals in the mail. Please return a copy of the completed referral, so I can update your child's health information. Thank you!

As we head into the winter months, we see an increase in cold and flu symptoms. Please keep your child home if they have a fever of 100\* or greater, vomiting/diarrhea, persistent cough, unknown rashes, pinkeye, or in general not feeling well. This helps your child get well faster, and helps reduce the spread of germs.

### ***Upcoming Bond Resolution***

During the January Board of Education meeting, the EPS School Board approved a bond issue resolution that would provide funds for land acquisition for future building sites, the construction of new schools and updates and remodels to several district buildings. Superintendent Dr. Bary Habrock is currently hosting community meetings to address the District's rapid growth and discuss plans for projects funded through the potential bond. ### ***SchoolMessenger Alerts***

Both the EPS District and each individual building regularly use a parent messaging system called SchoolMessenger to send emails and phone calls to parents, including monthly information about building happenings, as well as school closings.

SchoolMessenger also allows recipients the option to “unsubscribe” from its mailing list; please understand that by “unsubscribing” you are completely removing your email address from ALL lists, including both District and building specific emails.
