Our goal is to raise \$25,000 for the Arbor View PTO, and we need your help!

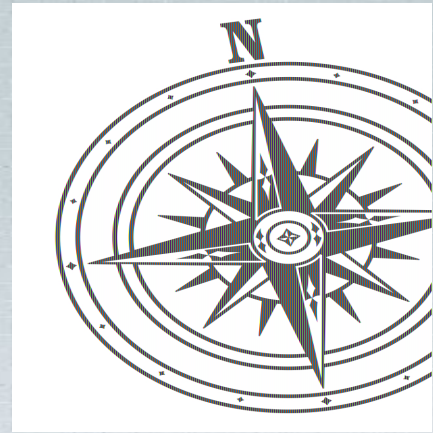

Breakfast Information-

Breakfast is served in the cafeteria on a daily basis beginning at 7:30. If children are arriving for breakfast they should enter the building using the main entrance (office) and proceed to the cafeteria. Door #14 is strictly used in the morning for our Elkhorn Kids Campus program.

We will also be providing the grab and go breakfast option again this year. Utilizing this option means kids can arrive to school at 7:55, go to walking club and then get a grab and go breakfast to eat in the classroom.

All breakfast meals are charged to the child's lunch account.

Drop off and pick up procedures: - Please review these and share with others who may pick up or drop off your children.

If you are planning on dropping off and picking up children in vehicles please be mindful of the following procedures.

1. The drop off lane runs directly in front of the school beginning at the southeast entrance ending in front of the preschool. A four way stop at 205th and Saratoga will guide all traffic into the drop off lane.
2. Pull as far forward as possible in the drop off lane. There are signs along the sidewalk in front of the building designating it as a loading/unloading zone. If staff members are waving you forward please don't take offense, we are trying to keep the line moving while keeping kids safe! When there is space to pull forward, please do.
3. **Children should exit cars anywhere along the curbside. Drivers should remain in cars during drop-off and pick up. This will help to speed up the process. If children need assistance getting out of the car or to the car, there will be adults to help. Please don't leave a vehicle unattended.**
4. Exit the drive on 208th street.
5. The parking lot on the south side of the building can be used if you'd like to walk your child(ren) to the school.
6. **There are four reserved parking spaces in the front of the building. These are designated as handicap spaces. Please do not use these without proper identification. Two of them are specifically designated for vans. We have multiple families who need these spots. Your cooperation is sincerely appreciated.**
7. Students will exit the building at 3:06 in the following locations:
 - Kindergarten:** Preschool entrance/exit just north of the main entrance to the building - door #2
 - 1st and 2nd grades:** Main entrance - door #1
 - 3rd and 4th grades:** East side of the gym - door #14
 - 5th grade:** Southeast entrance/exit leading into 5th grade - door #10
 - Kids can be picked up anywhere along the drop off and pick up lane.**
8. Older siblings are encouraged to walk to the front of the building, via the sidewalk, to wait with younger siblings for a ride or to walk home. Please let the teachers know if this is the plan.

Preschool -

When transporting your child to and from school, we ask that the children arrive no earlier than **8:15 a.m.** for the morning class and **12:15 p.m.** for the afternoon class, as we are trying to prepare for your child's day at school. **Staff will pick up students at the preschool door (#2) at 8:20 and 12:20 and will be dismissed from the preschool door at 11:30 and 3:30 each school day.**

If you are receiving special education transportation services, Denae Nuismer, Administrative Assistant for Student Services, will be contacting you to let you know the exact times your child will be picked up or dropped off. Please inform her of the days, times and addresses. If your child is going to be absent and receives transportation services, please call Denae at 289-2579 ext. 11000.


SCHOOLMESSENGER MESSAGING AND ALERT SYSTEM

Both the District and individual buildings regularly use a parent messaging system called SchoolMessenger to send emails and phone calls to parents such as monthly updates about building happenings and weather-related school closings.

SchoolMessenger also allows recipients the option to “unsubscribe” from its mailing list; please understand that by “unsubscribing” you are completely removing your email address from ALL lists, including both District and building specific emails. If you choose to Unsubscribe, you will not receive weather-related cancellation information.

If at any time you unsubscribe then later decide you would like to begin receiving emails again, please let your building secretary know.

Health Care Coverage for Nebraska Children

Cobertura para el cuidado médico de los niños de Nebraska

What is Nebraska's Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)? / Qué es CHIP

CHIP is health care coverage for qualified children who are without other health insurance and who do not qualify for Medicaid. Federally called the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), it provides the same services covered under Medicaid.

El programa CHIP es la cobertura de cuidado médico para los niños que califiquen y que no tengan ningún otro tipo de seguro médico ni sean elegibles para recibir Medicaid. Conocido al nivel federal como el Programa de Seguro Médico para Menores (CHIP), este programa proporciona lo mismos servicios cubiertos bajo Medicaid.

What does CHIP cover? / ¿Qué servicios cubre el programa a CHIP?

CHIP provides well care for your child in helping prevent diseases, finding and treating problems early, and maintaining good health and development.

CHIP proporciona cuidado para el bienestar de su hijo(a) al prevenir enfermedades, encontrar y tratar los problemas de manera oportuna, y mantener la buena salud y el desarrollo.

Regular check-ups include:

- Baby check-ups and baby immunizations
- Yearly check-ups for school-age children
- Immunization for school-age children
- Vision and hearing testing
- Dental check-ups and dental sealants

CHIP also provides medical care for injuries and illnesses

Treatment includes:

- Doctor's visits • Medications • Hospital care
- Lab tests/x-rays • Dental treatments • Eyeglasses
- Counseling
- Specialty services for children with disabilities or chronic health conditions
- Mental health and substance abuse assessment and treatment services

Los chequeos generales incluyen:

CHIP también proporciona cuidado médico para lesiones y enfermedades
