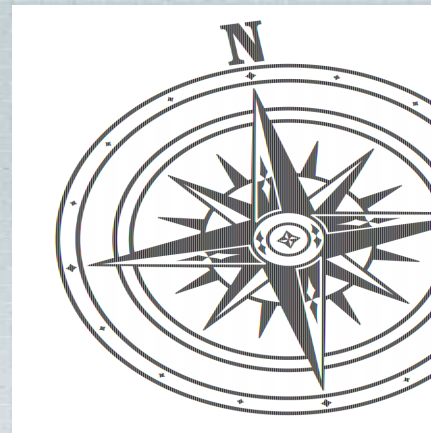

SchoolMessenger Alerts
