From the Desk of the Principal

As the school year comes to a close, the staff at Grandview is working on our end of the year awards. Sticking with tradition, the following awards will be given:

Missing Assignments

Each week, teachers are tracking and documenting the combined missing homework for students in a specific class period (ex: 6th grade is tracking their 8th hour class). Students with more than 3 total missing assignments (all classes), receive an email alert. This systematic approach ensures that every student at Grandview is being tracked and checked on every week. During distance learning, there is no penalty for turning in homework late.

Check & Connect

We know remote learning can be difficult for students and families. For students that are experiencing a more difficult time, we have initiated a Check & Connect program. Each week we are identifying students who are struggling to get homework done and are not receiving any type of additional support. These students are matched with a staff member who will reach out to parents and seek permission to conduct a 1-on-1 zoom session to check-in with the student and offer additional support and encouragement.

End of Year Parking Lot Parade!

The staff at Grandview is planning an End of Year Parking Lot Parade on Thursday, May 14! The time in the late afternoon/early evening is still TBD. The Grandview staff will line the parking lot at EGMS and students and families are encouraged to drive thru allowing students and teachers to see each other in person and say our good-byes for the summer. For safety reasons, we do not want students riding bikes or walking among all the traffic.

Students will be asked to come to the building on May 18 & 19 to turn in textbooks, novels, library books, band instruments, etc. Classroom binders/notebooks, award certificates and yearbooks will also be picked up by students. 

Pre Participation Physical Exam Requirements for 2020/21 School Year

The requirement for students entering the 7th grade to have a physical exam is Nebraska state education law and that requirement is not waived at this time. However, the physicals that the current 7th graders have for the 2019-2020 school year can be used for NSAA purposes for the 2020-2021 school year. All current 8th grade students that are going to enter the 9th grade in 2020, will **STILL** be required to get a physical exam for the 2020-2021 school year. All other high school students entering 10th, 11th & 12th grades that have the physical exam paperwork for 2019-2020 school year, can use that physical exam for the 2020-2021 school vear.

~ Medications for the 2019-2020 school year ~

If your student requires any medication (over-the-counter and/or prescription) while at school, <u>each</u> medication must have a <u>Medication Authorization</u> form signed by the parent and a physician, before we can administer. All medications must be unexpired and provided in the original packaging and/or pharmacy container. For prescription medication, please only provide a **maximum of 30 day supply** at a time.

If your child has <u>asthma</u>, <u>severe allergies</u>, diabetes, and/or seizures, please submit an emergency action plan signed by your physician. <u>Plans must be updated annually</u>. Blank forms can be obtained at the school office, clicking on link above, or your physician's office can use whatever form they prefer.

~ Incoming 7th Graders ~

Please remember that all incoming 7th graders are required by the State of Nebraska to have a physical exam and a Tdap booster <u>immunization</u>.

Coming Soon - ClassLink Parent Portal

Starting May 4th, 2020, parents will be able to sign up and log into the EPS ClassLink Parent Portal (https://parents.classlink.com/elkhorn). As you may know, ClassLink is a single-sign-on platform allowing users to input their credentials (username and password) for applications, one time, for easier access.

The purpose and intent of the EPS ClassLink Parent Portal is to ease parent access during the online registration form submission process and throughout the school year. Once parents log in to the ClassLink Parent Portal, they will see the three main applications used during the back to school process: 1 - PowerSchool Parent Portal, 2 - rSchool (Athletic Registration Account Login), and 3 - School Payment Portal - Parents.

Parents will need to have their credentials available for these three applications once they sign into the EPS ClassLink Parent Portal.
