TA is a structured homeroom or advisement program. What makes a 9th grade TA special is that 9th graders are grouped together to help make a smooth transition from middle school to high school with the help of three upperclassmen TA mentors and a TA advisor. It allows for freshman to build relationships with one another as well as make connections with upperclassmen.
