

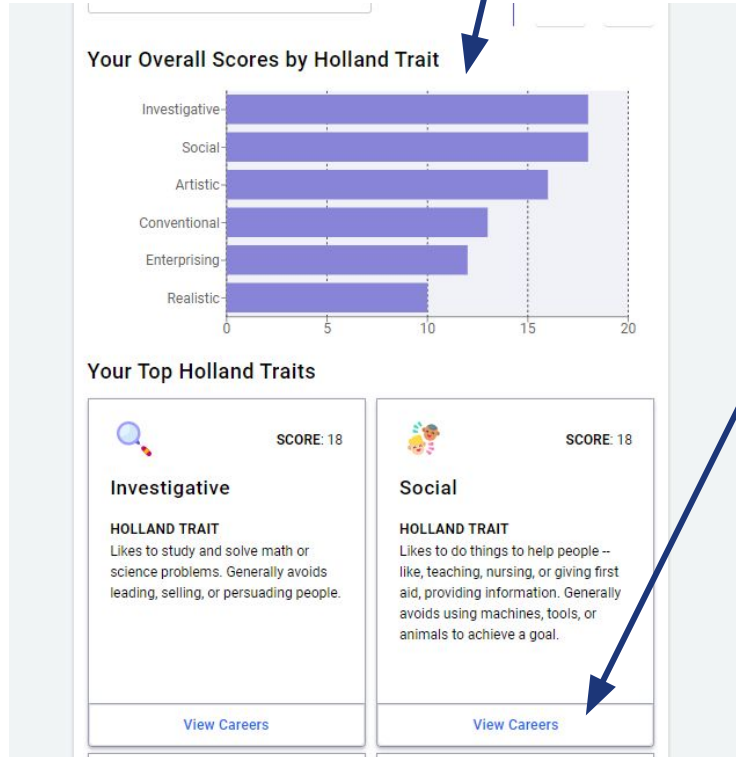


You are unique. Not every career that matches a personality type will be a match to your interests, skills, aspirations, or desired lifestyle. The trick is to discover the ones that do.
