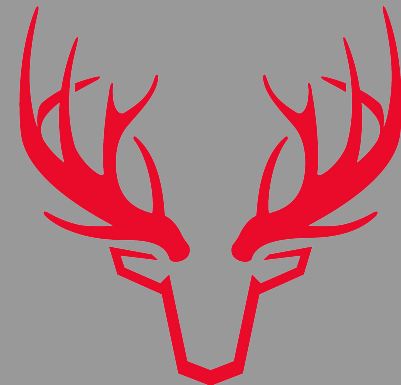

How are the recommendations on the registration sheet made?

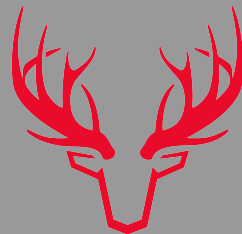
- **Honors English**

- **If you are interested, contracts are due: March 4th.**

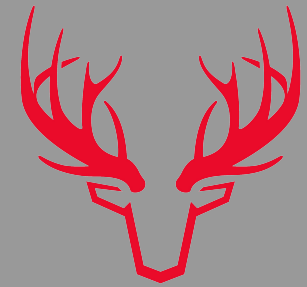
Optional Summer School – Personal Finance and Careers Online
