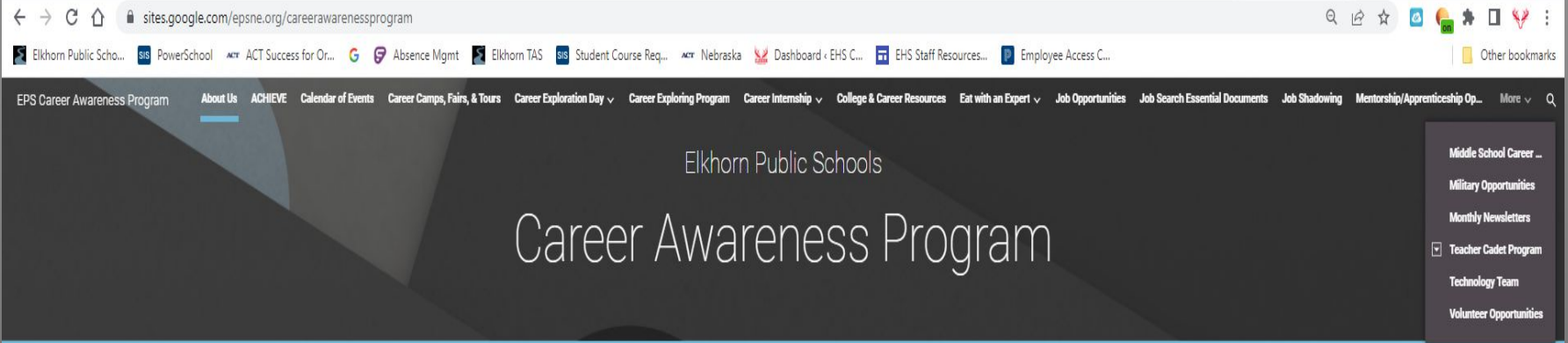
How Much World Language Should You Take?

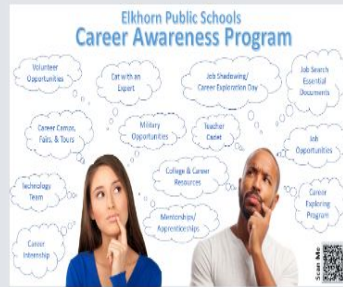
