WELCOME TO ENRMS!

Thank you for a fantastic beginning to launch Elkhorn North Ridge Middle School! We at ENRMS are grateful for a very positive and supportive parent community. Thank you for screening your child's health status prior to sending him or her to school. We know that consistent attendance makes a difference in a child's learning, but we must balance that with the safety of other students, teachers, and staff members. The following are some attendance policy reminders:

- Students that arrive to school after the 8:10 A.M. bell will be counted as tardy.
- All students must be excused verbally by a parent or guardian. Please remember to call the office (not teachers) when reporting a student tardy or absent.
- Students who are absent for professional appointments must either provide documentation from the appointment or call the school office to inform the school why the student will be (or is) tardy.
- Excessive tardies may result in disciplinary action and contact from the administration.

DROP-OFF, PICK-UP, and SAFETY

Thanks to all parents for the courtesy and cooperation demonstrated during the morning dropoff and afternoon pick-up times. Just a few reminders and a few requests:

- doors open at 7:45AM before school and supervision ends at 3:45PM after school; keep these times in mind when making arrangements to drop off and pick up your students
- while in the pick-up line, please PULL FORWARD; if there is space in front of you, continue to pull forward even if you pass your child and he/she must walk to you
- please follow these rules whether you are dropping off or picking up your child in the front or back of the school building



GOOGLE CLASSROOM

GUARDIAN EMAIL SUMMARIES

Guardians can receive email summaries about their student's activity in Google Classroom. Guardians need to accept the invitation in order to receive Google Classroom email summaries. We will go live in early September, but you may already have accepted an invitation. Email summaries do not include grades. In email summaries, you can review:

- Missing work working not turned in when the summary was sent
- 2. Upcoming work work that is due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
- 3. Class activities announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers

If there is no activity to report or if a teacher turns off email notifications, you might not get an email summary. Please reach out to your child's teacher if you are not receiving this information.

EPS PHOTO PERMISSION EXPLANATION

As part of the annual online registration process, all EPS students must elect their photo permission for the school year. A detailed explanation of the three options available for students to choose from is below.

YES:

- Student photo and video can be utilized by the District for purposes deemed appropriateunder
 FERPA in print, digitally within EPS buildings, and electronically on the web or social media
- Student video will be shown when utilizing distance-learning platforms such as Zoom
- Student photo and video can be shared with and featured in local media sources

NO:

- Student photo and video will not appear or be shared in any format for any purpose
- Student photo will not be included in school yearbook
- Student video will not be shown when utilizing distance learning platforms such as Zoom
- Student photo and video cannot be shared with local media partners including photos for extracurricular activities and groups

YEARBOOK ONLY:

- Student photo will be featured only in the school yearbook
- Student video will not be shown when utilizing distance learning platforms such as Zoom
- Student photo and video will not be shared with local media partners including photos for extracurricular activities and groups

After reviewing these explanations, if you feel that the option you originally chose for your student does not accurately reflect your desired choice, please contact your building administrative assistant to update it.
