### Reminder to Screen for Symptoms at Home

Please help us reduce the possibility of COVID exposures here at school by screening your student daily for symptoms. Thank you!

Students with any one of the following symptoms should remain at home:

- New cough
- New onset of shortness of breath
- New loss of taste or smell

Students with two or more of the following symptoms should remain at home:

- Fever 100.4 or above
- Chills
- Muscle aches
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue

### **Appointment Reminders**

Any student needing to leave school during the day for an appointment must check out with the office before leaving. No student will be dismissed unless the following has occurred:

Parents/guardians have contacted the school office and arranged for the dismissal (by phone or note). The student will be given a pass to leave the classroom, sign out in the office, and meet you at the front door at the requested time. This process allows for minimal disruption to the classroom while allowing you to pick up your child as needed. We appreciate your efforts to schedule appointments outside of school hours when possible.



This year will have some restrictions compared to other years due to COVID-19 and district policies. Teams will be required to meet at school to create their team solutions and prepare for the competitions. Snacks <u>will NOT</u> be allowed this year and masking protocols will be addressed, when needed, based on school exposures. DI participants should follow the EPS social distancing guidelines at all times.

Things to know about DI this year: (Middle School DI is for students in 6th-8th grade)

- ♦ There will be an annual fee for each student participant of \$20
- ◆ We need parents to manage each team of students (maximum of seven kids per team)
- ♦ Teams that were together last year can stay together this year
- ♦ Team Mangers will need to complete a background check through EPS at no cost
- ♦ Teams will meet at school (after school, evenings, weekends) and follow the current EPS COVID guidelines
- Every team will need a team Appraiser (judge) to help with the Regional and State competitions
- ◆ Team Managers and Appraisers will need to complete some online training
