MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) Testing

For the next two weeks, students at ERMS will be participating in MAP testing. This is an adaptive, computerized test that is given to student 2 to 3 times a year in the areas of Reading, Math, Language Arts, and Science. These assessments are used to measure and monitor student progress throughout the school year. Our staff uses the assessment data to make plans, create goals, and progress monitor our students. What's nice about this system is that it's the same software that is used for state testing. This makes it very familiar and comfortable to students each time they are in a testing session. Students will be given their personal MAP scores to show during student led conferences on September 24 and 25.

Join "Destination ImagiNation!" (DI)

DI is a world-wide, fun and creative problem solving competition in which students are able to work together in small teams of 4-7 students. Over the next several months, students will choose one of six DI challenges, interpret that challenge, and solve it using critical thinking skills and creativity. Some of the challenges include the construction of technical devices. Other challenges are more fine arts and theater-based. Each team will have the opportunity to solve their problem the way that they interpret it.

Regionals, the first competition, will be held in early March 2020 (date and location to be announced soon). The State competition will be held in Kearney at UNK on Saturday, March 28, 2020. Globals is now in Kansas City and will be held in late May 2020.

Each team needs a parent Team Manager to help the students manage their time and solutions. Being a DI team manager is a great way to get involved and watch how kids can solve multi-level challenges using their talents and creativity. Meetings will be outside of the school day and will be held at ERMS. All EPS district DI teams are required to meet in our school buildings. A "Facility Use" form is required to reserve your space and times. Team Manager training will be provided by NCAPS (Nebraska's Creative Association for Problem Solvers) for the parent volunteers in October.

To form a team, students should get their friends together (4-7 total), recruit a parent manager, and turn in the team roster to the ERMS front office by Friday, September 13th, 2019. Please include full first and last names, and phone numbers of all student team members. Please turn in the Team Manager's name, phone numbers and email address. Students who do not have a team put together can email Melinda Ghannam at mghannam@epsne.org for assistance in finding a team to join.

REMINDERS FROM YOUR SCHOOL NURSE ...

We want to take great care of your student, and one way to help us do that is to provide the health office with current health information.

If your student has any health needs such as Asthma, Severe Allergy, Diabetes, Seizures, etc we **must** have an *action plan* on file that is signed by the doctor and the parent. This information is very important, so we know exactly what is best to do for your student, in the event of an emergency. Please remember if your student has any medications such as an inhaler, Epi-Pen, Benedryl, etc to be used in an emergency situation, we need to have those available at school, with a signed medication authorization, so trained staff can administer.

If your student requires **any** medication while at school, this includes all prescription and/or all over-the-counter (e.g. ibuprofen, acetaminophen, cough drops, etc) ALL MEDICATION requires a medication authorization, signed by the physician and the parent. All medication must be unexpired and provided in the original store packaging or pharmacy labeled container to the health office.
