TRAFFIC REMINDERS

Please keep the following things in mind during drop off and pick up times:

- Slow down, watch for safety patrol members
- Right turn only out of front loop
- Make sure kids can buckle and unbuckle independently
- Pull forward
- Kids enter and exit car curbside only
- Do not walk across front loop entry
- Come to a full stop at the 4 way stop behind the crosswalk

Office Reminders:

- Please call the office by 9 AM if your child is going to be absent.
- If your child is tardy for school, a parent needs to come in to the office to sign in.
- If you are picking your child up early, please call the office 10-15 min. before you plan to arrive and we will have your child waiting in the office.
- If your child is getting to school before 7:55 AM, there is no supervision during their wait outside. One option would be for your child to eat breakfast.

 Breakfast begins at 7:30 AM. At that time, students will be allowed to come in through the front doors.

No Dogs on School Grounds

Reminders From Your School Nurse...

If you haven't done so already, please get those required kindergarten physical and vision exams turned in, and copies of updated vaccines. We want to take great care of your child, and one way to help us do that is to provide the health office with current health information and medication needed for your child.

If your child has any health needs such as Asthma, Severe Allergy, Diabetes, Seizures, etc. we must have an *action plan* on file that is signed by the doctor and the parent. This information is very important, so we know exactly what is best to do for your child, in the event of an emergency.

Please remember if your student has any medications such as an inhaler, Epi-Pen, Benedryl, etc to be used in an emergency situation, we need to have those available at school, with a signed medication authorization, so trained staff can administer.

If your child requires **any** medication while at school, this includes all prescription and/or all over-the-counter (e.g. ibuprofen, acetaminophen, cough drops, etc)

ALL MEDICATION requires a medication authorization, signed by the physician and the parent. All medication must be unexpired and provided in the original store packaging or pharmacy labeled container.

SCHOOLMESSENGER MESSAGING AND ALERT SYSTEM

Both the EPS District and each individual building regularly use a parent messaging system called SchoolMessenger to send emails and phone calls to parents, including monthly information about building happenings, as well as school closings.

SchoolMessenger also allows recipients the option to "unsubscribe" from its mailing list; please understand that by "unsubscribing" you are completely removing your email address from ALL lists, including both District and building specific emails.

If, at any time, you unsubscribe then later decide you would like to begin receiving emails again, please let your building secretary know.

TECH SAVVY PARENT TIPS

As students and parents get back into the school year, it's important to remember to prioritize time and focus on schoolwork. For students, procrastination generally takes on the form of "multitasking", which often leads to distractions and wasted time. In order to curb this occurrence prior to it becoming a bad habit that will move with them into adulthood, take a look at a few options for apps and plugins that help reduce the instances of this current trend.

<u>RescueTime</u>: this plug-in tracks how much time is being spent on specific sites and generates reports showing the results. By reviewing these reports, you and your child can see exactly where the majority of their time is being wasted.

<u>Work Mode</u>: Work Mode blocks access to all social media feeds during any time frame that the plug-in is turned on. What better way to ensure your child is focused solely on the task at hand than by making the distractions they typically default to inaccessible during the time they need to be focusing on other important things?
