
An Author/Illustrator Is Coming To Your School!

Author/illustrator, Bruce Arant will be visiting our school to speak to our students. He wrote and illustrated Simpson's Sheep Won't Go To Sleep! (2013 Peter Pauper Press) as well as that book's sequel, Simpson's Sheep Just Want to Sleep! (2017 Peter Pauper Press). His first Simpson's Sheep book was a 2015-2016 Golden Sower nominee. The book also won two 2014 Nebraska Book Awards, and in 2016 it was appointed to the Nebraska 150 Book List.

In the first book, Farmer Simpson's sheep think of every possible excuse to stay awake at bedtime. Finally, he discovers a cozy solution that lulls his sheep right to sleep. The second book presents the opposite problem ... Simpson's sheep just want to sleep! It's a fun, yet tender tale about the virtues of using a gentle nudge when friends won't budge.


Dear Parents and Families:

We will be using the automated conference scheduler called Pick-A-Time for our parent/teacher conferences again. Conferences will be held Tuesday October 16 and Wednesday October 17 from 3:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. each evening. Please see the information below on how to proceed with scheduling your child's time.

This is a first-come first-serve scheduling software. The online scheduler will open up at 10:00 a.m. on Monday October 1, 2018 and close at 11:50 p.m. on Sunday October 14, 2018. As a result, the sooner you register the more likely you are to get your preferred time. Already Registered

If you were at Hillrise in the fall, you will not need to re-register to set up conferences with your children. Use the same email and password that you used in October.

Register (New to Hillrise)

1. Enter your email address and push "Login/Create Account". 2. Fill in the required fields and register. 3. Where it asks for Student ID, enter your child's first and last name. Use their legal name (Example: John Smith). Next, enter the student's birthday (Example: 12/15/2005).

Scheduling

1. Each colored square represents an available meeting time. The legend/key shows you what each color means. Click on a square to book that time. 2. As an option, you have the choice of setting a time when you would like a reminder email delivered. 3. Click "Create Appointment" to finalize. 4. You cannot create back to back appointments unless your children have the same classroom teacher.

Repeat until you have a time scheduled for each of your children. Logout when finished.

Notes

• At any time, you can click on "printable schedule" and print the resulting web page to get a hard copy of your schedule. You will also have the option to email your schedule to yourself.

 \bullet Click on "Your Schedule" to display and hide your appointments. There will be links to change the time or cancel the appointment.

• If you need to make changes after October 14th, you will need to contact Sandi Joiner in the office at 402-289-2602.




