Welcome to the 2022-23 school year! I hope everyone had an enjoyable summer break with family. It is with great pleasure and pride that I serve as the Manchester principal. Our Manchester students make immense growth year after year due to the strong home school partnerships. The staff and I are dedicated to partnering with you again this year. Student safety is always at the forefront of our mind. Please review the importance of using the crosswalk as well as safe walking and biking habits with your children. When we hold a lock down drill students are informed prior that it is only practice. I will email parents, to let everyone know that the drill was practiced. Additionally, we team with law enforcement through the Safe2Help hotline. It is an anonymous hotline students and parents can use to report concerning situations (see the graphic below).

Please note the start time for incoming kindergarten students on the first day of school. Our kindergartners will start school on the 16th at 9:00 a.m. this helps our youngest students make the transition to their new school easier.

Please review the traffic guidelines below. Student safety is our number one priority, so please let me know if you have questions regarding the procedures.

Standard Response Protocol

STANDARD RESPONSE PROTOCOL
Tornado, Lockdown, Fire, Bomb Threat, Active Shooter

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS
The Standard Response Protocol (SRP) is based on an all-hazards approach to school safety. Like the Incident Command System (ICS), SRP allows clear common language with allowing for flexibility in protocol.

COMMON LANGUAGE
The purpose is simple - there are no specific actions that are performed during an incident. When communicating with parents and the community, the SRP is based on the following actions: Hold, Evacuate, Shelter, Lockdown, and Secure.

HOLD
"In the classroom or room"
Students are instructed to:
• Clear the hallway and remain in their area or room until the "All Clear"
• Do business as usual

ADULTS AND STAFF are trained to:
• Close and lock the door
• Account for students and adults
• Do business as usual

SECURE
"Outside doors"
Students are instructed to:
• Return to inside of building
• Do business as usual
• Bring everyone inside
• Lock the outside doors
• Increase disabled awareness
• Account for students and adults
• Do business as usual

EVACUATE
"By Location"
Students are trained to:
• Leave all staff and students to follow instructions
• Bring all staff and students instructed not to bring anything with them. (dependent on reason for evacuation)
• Least students to Evacuation location
• Report injuries or problems using Red Cross Green Card protocol

SHELTER
"Take Shelter and Safety Strategy"
Students are trained to:
• Shelter
• Increase disabled awareness
• Account for students and adults
• Report injuries or problems using Red Cross Green Card protocol

Safety Strategies might include:
• Evacuate to shelter area
• Shut the room
• Crawl, cover and hold
• Get to high ground
• Accommodate Handicaps and Safety Strategies
• Account for students and adults
• Report injuries or problems using Red Cross Green Card protocol

• Bring all staff and students instructed not to bring anything with them. (dependent on reason for evacuation)
• Least students to Evacuation location
• Report injuries or problems using Red Cross Green Card protocol

SHOULD PARENTS COME TO THE SCHOOL DURING A SECURE EVENT?
No. Parents should not come to the school during a secure event. The school will contact parents if a secure event occurs. Parents should remain at home and follow instructions from the school.

SHOULD PARENTS TEXT THEIR STUDENTS?
No. Parents should not text their students during a secure event. The school will contact parents if a secure event occurs. Parents should remain at home and follow instructions from the school.

WHAT IF PARENTS NEED TO PICK UP THEIR STUDENT?
If a parent needs to pick up their student during a secure event, they should call the school to arrange for pickup. The school will provide instructions on how to proceed.

WILL PARENTS BE NOTIFIED WHEN A SCHOOL GOES INTO LOCKDOWN?
Yes. Parents will be notified via email, text, or phone call when a school goes into lockdown.

Let's Work Together To Keep our Students Safe- Please Follow the Manchester Traffic Guidelines

2022-23 Manchester Elementary Traffic Plan

Morning Supervision/Walking Club begins: 7:55 a.m.

Breakfast: 7:35 a.m.

First bell: 8:10 a.m.

Tardy bell: 8:15 a.m.

Dismissal: 3:03 p.m. (walkers/ bikers)

3:06 p.m. (students picked up in a vehicle)

Drop Off

- Only turn right into the drive thru lane (follow posted traffic signs).
- Avoid dropping students off in the staff parking lot.
- Pull as far forward as possible, when the line stops children exit the vehicle curbside (between the kindergarten ramp all the way to the EKC doors, see yellow marking on the map).
- Staff members will assist the students, adults please stay in the vehicle.
- Students exit the vehicle on the passenger side only.



Pick Up

- Display the provided hang tag in your rearview mirror when you enter the drive thru lane. The hang tag system helps us safely and efficiently dismiss your child to the proper vehicle. Please provide a hang tag to the person who will pick up your student. If an additional one is needed, please call the office.
 - Pull as far forward as possible.
 - Adults remain in the vehicles, staff will assist the students.
 - Children enter vehicles on the passenger side only.

Walkers/Bike riders

- Students cross HWS Cleveland Blvd. at the crosswalk and follow the directions of Safety Patrol.
- Students need to promptly ride bikes or walk home, they are not allowed to play on the playgrounds immediately after school (EKC uses the space and there is no supervision available).
- Kindergarten walkers will be dismissed from the classroom kindergarten doors (see the orange star on the above map).

Keep our students safe, follow these rules when you travel to and from school.

- Yield to walkers and bikers, follow the guidance of Safety Patrol and staff members.
- Only turn right into the drive thru lane.
- Only enter the left drive thru lane once you have passed Safety Patrol and the corner of the building.
- Stay in your vehicle when in the drive thru lane.
- Do not park in the curbside lane before or after school.
- Practice the routine with your child before the start of the year, including buckling and unbuckling the seatbelts independently and safely using the crosswalk.
- Drop off students along the drop off zone, do not drop off in the staff lot.
- Do not drop off or pick up at the three-way stop, it impedes traffic and is dangerous for our students.
- There is no parking on either side of HWS Cleveland Blvd. from Locust St. to 175th St. Please respect the traffic signs and either park on Wirt St. or 175th St. or simply drop-off and pick-up your children in the curbside lane (see map above).

At 8:45 a.m. the Kindergarten teachers will be in front of the school to meet their students on the 16th.

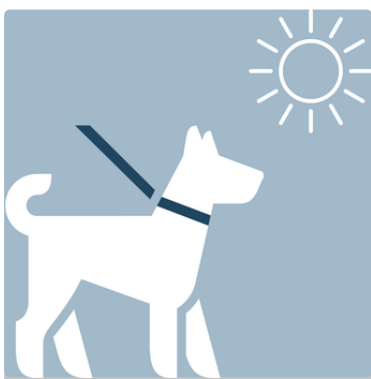
On the second day of school, kindergarten students will enter through the main doors at head directly to their classrooms beginning at 7:55 a.m.

School Basics

- The first day of school is August 16th. The school day begins at 8:10 a.m. with the tardy bell ringing at 8:15 a.m. Dismissal for walkers is at 3:03 p.m. and 3:06 p.m for students picked up through the car line. Please make every effort to ensure your student(s) arrive on time.
- Walking Club begins at 7:55 a.m. (on the third day of school). Children arriving to school between 7:55 and 8:07 a.m. will participate in this supervised activity. Walking Club begins Thursday, August 18th. Please leave pets at home when on the school campus. Parents/guardians are more than welcome to join their children during Walking Club.
- Breakfast will be served daily between 7:35- 8:00 a.m. Students will enter through the side EKC doors and will enjoy their breakfast in the cafeteria then join Walking Club when they're finished eating.
- If your child is not attending school due to an illness or appointment, please call the school office at 402-289-2590 or email at manchester@epsne.org.
- Students who leave early or arrive late must sign in/out at the front office.

Visitor Guidelines

At Manchester, the doors remain locked during the school day. All visitors will gain access using the security camera/access panel outside of the school's main entrance. Office staff will grant access after you do the following steps:

1. Push the button and wait for the identification request.
2. Provide your name and purpose for entering the school.
3. When you hear the door unlatch, enter and proceed to the office.
4. Sign in on the visitor sheet and take a visitor sticker/badge.
5. When leaving the building, return to the office and sign out.

Lunch and Breakfast Information/Menus

2022-23 Meals Due to the USDA waivers not being extended, EPS does not qualify to serve free meals. Therefore, for the 2022-23 school year, free meals will only be available to those who qualify for free or reduced meals based on income guidelines and application submission.

Lunch Visitors

Parents are welcome to join their child(ren) for lunch; however, having too many visitors during the first few days can make learning the lunch procedures challenging for students. We would ask that parents wait to join us for lunch until Monday, August 22. Hi there and welcome back to school! My name is Sara Bird and I am the school nurse for Manchester Elementary School, Grandview Middle School, and Elkhorn North High School. I am in each building 2 half days per week, but if you ever need to contact me please feel free to email me at sbird@epsne.org with any questions or concerns you may have.



Here is some important information to review:

Physical and Immunization Requirements

Nebraska law requires that all school children have a physical examination upon entry into school, at seventh grade, and when transferring from an out-of-state school. Students must also provide proof of a visual evaluation to include testing for amblyopia, strabismus, internal and external eye health and visual acuity upon entry into school and when transferring from an out-of-state school. The law also requires your child be immunized and provide proof of immunization before attending classes. All

7th grade students are required to have a Tdap vaccine. Please visit this link: [Summary of the School Immunization Rules and Regulations](#) to view specific vaccine requirements for the age of your child. If you have not turned in your Kindergarten, 7th grade, or new out-of-state student's paperwork, please do so ASAP. This may be uploaded during the registration process but please be sure to select "actual size" so your documents are legible.

Medication Policy

If your student requires any medication (over-the-counter and/or prescription) while at school, each medication must have a [Medication Authorization Form](#) signed by the parent and a physician before we can administer. All medications must be unexpired and provided in the original packaging and/or pharmacy container. For prescription medications, please only provide a maximum of 30 day supply at a time. All medication must be dropped off in the office by a parent or guardian. Please do not send any medications with your student. Also, if you believe your student is capable of managing their own inhaler or epi pen while at school, here is the link for the [Self-management Of Asthma and Severe Allergy \(Anaphylaxis\) at School Consent/release form](#).

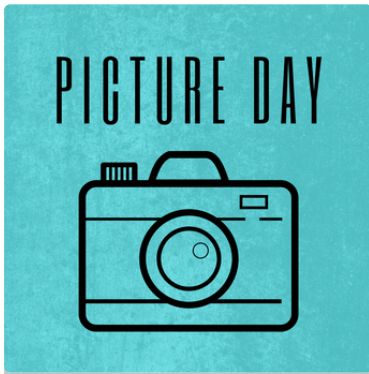
Students with Asthma, Severe Allergies, Diabetes, and/or Seizures

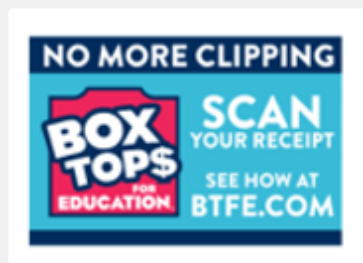
