APRIL TECH TIP

Phishing Scams: Phishing is a form of social engineering that attempts to steal sensitive information. An attacker's goal is to compromise systems to obtain usernames, passwords, and other account and/or financial data. They most frequently accomplish phishing attacks via email. The attacker sends crafted emails to people within an organization. The email usually pretends to be from someone trustworthy, like your bank, UPS/FedEx, a credit card company or an airline, or some other site for which you may have login credentials. The email includes a link to an "official" website that is actually a fake site operated by the attacker. Once the user visits the fake site, they may be asked overtly to enter account information such as usernames, passwords, credit card details, social security or bank account numbers. If done correctly, the attack can capture sensitive information without the victim even knowing that they have been compromised. 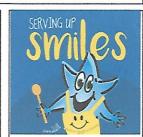

Plants Are the Backbone of Life on Earth

Our everyday life depends on plants in so many ways. Let's review some of the special purposes of plants on Earth:

- Food: Everything we eat comes directly or indirectly from plants. Throughout human history, approximately 7,000 different plant species have been used as food by people.
- Water: Plants regulate the water cycle: they help distribute and purify the planet's water. They also help move water from the soil to the atmosphere through a process called transpiration.
- Medicine: One-quarter of all prescription drugs come directly from or are derivatives of plants.
- 4. <u>Air:</u> Oxygen is brought to you by plants, as a by-product of photosynthesis.
- 5. <u>Habitat:</u> Species of fish and wildlife depend on plants for food and shelter.
- Climate: Plants store carbon, and have helped keep much of the carbon dioxide produced from the burning of fossil fuels out of the atmosphere.

STRAWBERRY BANANA SANDWICHES (SERVES 4)

1/4 cup bananas (sliced) 1/2 cup strawberries (sliced) 4–2.4 oz. slices french toast 1/4 cup light cream cheese

Slice bananas and strawberries 1/4".

. To build sandwich:

- Spread 1 Tbsp cream cheese on each slice of frozen French toast.
- Place 1/8 cup sliced banana on top of cream cheese on 1 slice of bread.
- Top banana with 1/4 cup sliced strawberries.
- Close sandwich with 2nd slice of bread.
- Place sandwiches on parchment lined sheet pans.
- At service, cut sandwiches in half diagonally.
