This Signup Genius will either be sent by PTO volunteers or teachers if it is for a classroom/grade level event. Anybody who signs up on the Signup Genius will enter the building using standard procedures and will be given a premade nametag.



WHEN IS MY CHILD TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL? Proper care in the early stages of an illness can reduce recovery time for the ill child and reduce the possibility of spreading the illness to others. Proper diet, adequate rest, and good personal hygiene (especially frequent handwashing) can assist the body's ability to fight infection.

The following are guidelines to assist you in deciding when your child should stay home from school:

Irritability, poor appetite, tiredness, achiness are vague symptoms. Changes in a child's normal behavior can often signal the beginning of an illness.

Fever of 100 degrees or higher. Take your child's temperature if he is complaining of feeling tired, headache, sore throat or stomach ache. A child should be fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication before returning to school.

Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea. Keep your child at home for the duration of these symptoms. No vomiting or diarrhea for the past 24 hours is recommended. Be sure your child is able to tolerate food without difficulty before returning.

Nasal secretions and coughing/sneezing spread respiratory infections easily when these symptoms can't be controlled.

Suspected communicable conditions such as undiagnosed rashes, pink eye, ringworm, or chickenpox. A child must be sent home until identified symptoms are evaluated and conditions for return to school are provided by a healthcare provider.

West Bay uses the Pick-A-Time Scheduler for Parent/Teacher Conferences. The on-line scheduler will open at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 2, 2020 and will close at 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, February 16, 2020. Please follow the step by step instructions to help you schedule a conference for your child/children.

Already Registered...

If you were at West Bay Elementary or West Bay Preschool first semester, you will not need to re-register to set up conferences for your children. Use the same email and password that you previously used.

New to West Bay or West Bay Preschool after November, 2019:

- 1. Enter your email address and select "Login/Create Account".
- 2. Fill in the required fields and register.
- 3. For each child, where it asks for student ID, please enter your child's first and last name (example: JohnSmith). Enter the student's birth date (example: 12/15/2005)

Scheduling

1. Each colored square represents an available meeting time.

The legend/key shows you what each color means. Click on a square to book that time.

- 2. As an option, you have the choice of setting a time when you would like a Reminder email delivered.
 - 3. Click "Create Appointment" to finalize.

Repeat until you have a time for each of your children.

Notes

At any time, you can click on "**printable schedule**" and print the resulting web page to get a hard copy of your schedule. You will also have the option to email your schedule to yourself.

You have the ability to change your conference times through February 16, 2020 at 11:59 pm. You will need to log in with the email address and password you used to create your account. If you need to make a change after February 16th, please contact Jane Greve in the office at (402) 289-9045.

Click on "Your Schedule" to display and hide your appointments. There will be links to change the time or cancel the appointment.
