Receipts for qualifying products are accepted from both in-store and online purchases. The app is the best way to scan and submit receipts. Plus, the app always has the latest listings of qualifying products and details on all bonus offers ~ bonuses really do add up! It is not uncommon to see bonus offers that are held multiple times per year by a variety of stores which provide 50 bonus Box Tops for the purchase of five General Mills products – which equals \$5. You can also link your Box Tops account with Boxed, a bulk shopping service, to earn even more at select times throughout the year.

What if I find a traditional Box Top on a product? If you find it and it still has a valid, unexpired date, then you can submit these clipped Box Tops yourself by following directions at: https://www.boxtops4education.com/Coordinator-Submit-Box-Tops

What if I ordered groceries online and don't have a physical receipt to scan? No worries! Just forward the exact e-receipt that you were emailed to: receipts@boxtops4education.com within 14 days of purchase. Regardless of whether you scan a receipt or forward an e-receipt; it is considered a best practice to provide the full image, rather than a partial receipt that only shows applicable purchases. Emails to Box Tops will not result in unsolicited emails from other companies.

What happens if I scan my receipt, but it doesn't flag any of the valid purchases? This can be frustrating when and if it happens. Sometimes, you can just follow the prompts on the app to scan the barcode of the product(s) in question and that will generally work right away. Other times, you may have to escalate the issue by sending your full receipt image and expected earnings to the Box Tops for Education Team at: btfe.support@genmills.com.


