Hello Westridge Families,

Welcome to 2020! The start of a new year is always fun and exciting. I think of this as a time to reflect on the past year and think about ways to be better in the upcoming year. We know that many New Year resolutions don't last very long. Most of the time it is because we set unrealistic goals. We know that when we set goals that are realistic and are broken down into a shorter length of time, such as two weeks instead of an entire year, we are much more likely to reach those goals. Learning how to set realistic goals is also important for our students. Teaching them how to set short-term manageable goals will allow them to learn to use goal setting as a tool for improvement and to build confidence as they become more successful. I would encourage all of you to have your child set a goal at home, even for just the next two weeks. It could be as simple as reading 5 more minutes each night, or get homework done right after school each day this week. Then track their progress and celebrate when they meet the goal. This will help them learn the importance of using goals to grow and develop in their lives.

Report cards will be coming home on Friday, January 10<sup>th</sup>. We are also hosting our Westridge Math Night on Thursday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. Our theme this year is Math Attack! ## Westridge Online Directory 2019/2020

1. Go to <https://atozconnect.com/>
2. Click LOG IN in upper right hand corner
3. Click bottom where it says "sign up now"
4. Enter school zip code: **68022**, Westridge will auto populate. Fill in your email and phone



1. New screen will pop up. Fill in your home information, then move to the tab to the right. Fill in the "parent" tab, then the "add student" tab.



2. Once done with all 3 tabs click "create account" at the bottom of the page.
