I wanted to say a big THANK YOU to the parents that helped at health screening! I really appreciate your help in getting the students screened quickly and back to class!

I wanted to send some reminders as we head into the winter months. We see an increase in cold, flu and COVID symptoms during these months, it is important to continue to monitor your child on a daily basis for any symptoms. Please keep your child home, until symptom free for 24 hours, if they have a fever of 100\* or greater, vomiting/diarrhea, persistent cough, unknown rashes, pink eye, or in general not feeling well. Thank you parents for what you are doing to prevent the spread of germs at school! Have safe and happy holidays!
