• If you received a health screen referral letter within the last few months please visit the appropriate medical professional and have them complete the bottom portion of the letter and return it to school with your child if you have not already done so.

It's not too early to start scheduling your school and sports physicals!



- o Students who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall or who are new students from out of state will need to submit a physical exam and vision exam (including test for strabismus, amblyopia, and acuity) dated after February 15, 2023, as well as a current immunization record including the Kindergarten booster shots. Here is the Summary of the School Immunization Rules and Regulations
- Students entering the 7th grade in the fall will need to submit a physical exam dated after February 15, 2023 and an updated immunization record including a Tdap booster.
- \circ Students wanting to participate in a sport at the middle school or high school must have a **sports physical** completed sometime after **May 1**, 2023 and uploaded to <u>rschool</u>.
- **Health records should be submitted to school prior to the first student day on Aug 15, 2023 .
- **7th graders still need to submit a physical exam to the front office as well, as these are different systems.

February is dental health and heart health month! Encourage your children to brush their teeth twice a day, floss once a day, and have a check up with a dentist every 6 months. Encourage eating a healthy diet and getting plenty of regular sleep and exercise to promote a healthy heart.
