2023-2024 Online Registration Reminder

For the upcoming school year, EPS will again utilize an online registration system that will allow parents of K-12 students to log in and update information and complete all Back-to-School documents. As a reminder, to use this feature, parents/guardians will need to have a parent-access account in PowerSchool.

A Note from the Nurse...

- Spring often brings with it an increase in symptoms of allergies and asthma. Please monitor your child and let us know if you have any additional concerns we need to be aware of or adjustments to his/her allergy/asthma action plan.
- On fun and field days be sure to apply sunscreen to your child before he/she comes to school.

* * It's time to start scheduling your child's school and sports physicals!

- Students who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall or who are new students from out of state will need to submit a physical exam and vision exam (including checks for internal and external eye health, strabismus, amblyopia, and acuity) dated after February 15, 2023 as well as a current immunization record including the Kindergarten booster shots. Here is the Summary of the School Immunization Rules and Regulations
- 5th grade students wanting to participate in running club at the middle school next year must have a sports physical completed sometime after May 1, 2023 and uploaded to <u>rschool</u>.

**Forms can also be uploaded to PowerSchool during the registration process in August but please click "Actual Size" or use the scan feature when uploading with a smartphone.

 As we are nearing the end of the school year--if your student has medication in the office, please be sure to pick it up on the last day of school.
